
- find partners to share the cost of operating the telescope

- Board review of science programme this autumn



Continued wide-field imaging with WFCAM

- UKIRT Hemisphere Survey (or something like it)
- interest from Pan-STARRS and JWST
- two potential instrument upgrades:
 - > use the focal plane more efficiently
 - > add polarimetric capability

Planet-hunting survey with UPF


- instrument build 2010–12, survey 2013–17
